A RESEARCH & DISCOVERY MISSION

Scott is a semi-retired elementary school teacher, retired house-framing carpenter, and philosopher who specializes in philosophy-based counseling and on-going research into optimizing counseling programs for any individual. Scott's philosophical research has attempted to map out and illustrate the connections between mind, body and spirit, with implications for speeded healing as a support therapy for medical recovery. Included in his research are health support counseling methodologies such as TIR (Traumatic Incident Reduction) and Dianetics (traumatic incident do-it-yourself therapy). Having mastered Dianetics therapy during his experience with official Scientology, and after whistleblowing corruption in its management, Scott set about pioneering non-religious, common-sense use of the repetitive Socratic questioning developed in the evolution of Scientology auditing, with application to secular programs alleviating trauma, similar to TIR and Metapsychology, known and accepted renditions in use by the counseling community. Addressing spiritual and mental effects of trauma and illness are a key element of the overall approach to self-improvement therapy, and working back-and-forth from the general to the specific - from a person's general case condition to specific incidents of trauma has given a broader overview of trauma and the healing process. One of Scott's contributions to this field has been discovering even more indirect, lighter methods of approach to heavy trauma through repetitive Socratic questioning, which can significantly alleviate trauma and facilitate healing, This lighter approach minimizes the phenomenon of "re-traumatization" that can occur when any approach is too direct, and is far easier for a trauma victim to confront. The essence of Scott's work has been facilitating improved methods of inner work that assist individuals to come out of their traumas, fears and disabilities and into states of personal and collective freedom.

Scott Gordon: (Overview) Dual Approach: First aid: Help resolve immediate issues and improve their current state of mind (increasing willingness). Deep work: Guide them to examine and confront root causes of trauma and misdeeds (building courage). Mental health issues are viewed not as "illnesses" but as individual combinations of mental mechanisms and complexes unique to each person. Beliefs like "statism" can be seen as mental complexes - built from rationalizations that resolve cognitive dissonance around irrational beliefs. A therapeutic approach involves: Examining deeply-held beliefs in a safe environment. Uncovering when/why irrational beliefs were adopted (often during trauma). Helping people regain conscious choice over previously unconscious beliefs. We may use a process alternating between examining what is "right" and "not right" about a belief until the person has a realization that helps them reclaim their autonomy from "authority hypnosis" (accepting others' beliefs under pressure/trauma).

Stephanie MoDavis: (Overview) Foundation: Healing requires addressing both inner (psychological) and outer (environmental) landscapes through truth and wholeness. Process: Look inward during physical illness. Examine feelings of powerlessness and authority dependence. Practice self-reflection, meditation, and shadow work. Cultivate forgiveness (both of others and self). Outcome: As individuals heal and reclaim sovereignty, they naturally: Inspire others, Engage more with community, Help build decentralized support systems, Form healthier relationships

Leslie Powers: (Overview) Treatment Approach: Consider each person's unique context and full bio/psycho/social system. Integrate mind, body, and spirit care. Work with nature's self-healing capabilities. Key Principles: Recognize human interconnectedness and mutual impact. Follow "Do No Harm." Support individual freedoms and Natural Law. Avoid harmful effects of centralized control. Individual Responsibility: Take charge of healthcare decisions. Seek accurate information. Choose personalized treatment options. Self-educate actively.

Cory Endrulat: (Overview) Core Methods: Socratic questioning/coaching through open dialogue. Radical honesty and consistent principles. Taoist philosophical wisdom.
